Skills & Qualifications:

Note: While membership is not required to volunteer as a Knowledge Contributor, preference is given to CCI Business Partner Members when sourcing and selecting experts or proposals.

- **Professional Expertise:** In-depth knowledge in condominium-related topics (e.g., law, property management, governance, finance, engineering, maintenance, etcetera).
- **Presentation & Public Speaking:** Strong communication skills, with the ability to present complex ideas clearly and engage audiences through Q&A or discussions.
- **Collaboration & Teamwork:** Ability to work effectively with CCI staff, fellow speakers, and moderators to ensure seamless delivery.

Key Responsibilities:

The following responsibilities apply to all Knowledge Contributor roles, ensuring smooth and effective engagement across various volunteer positions:

Collaboration

- Work closely with CCI staff to ensure seamless coordination and successful delivery.
- Work with moderators/fellow presenters to align on content, timing, and event goals.

Preparation

- Develop and deliver presentations or training sessions on agreed-upon topics, conducting research or analysis as needed.
- Create supporting materials, such as slides, resources, or handouts, to enhance the session and achieve desired outcomes.
- Submit all required materials by specified deadlines.
- For online events, participate in dry runs and test equipment and platforms in advance.
- For in-person events, arrange necessary travel and ensure on-site readiness.

Delivery & Engagement

- Adapt to changes in schedule, format, or content based on event or organizational needs.
- Represent CCI North Alberta and your organization professionally, demonstrating respect for fellow volunteers, staff, attendees, and industry competitors.
- Actively engage with attendees during Q&As, panel discussions, or networking opportunities.
- Foster meaningful dialogue by responding to questions and contributing to discussions in an informative and approachable manner.

INSITE Session Presenter

Purpose: Lead a focused 60-90 minute webinar on a specific topic relevant to the condominium community and share insights, provide resources or handout(s), and answer audience questions.

Time Commitment: Approx. 6-8 hours

- Coordination with CCI Staff: 1-2 hours.
- Individual Preparation: Estimated 3-5 hours for developing presentation and materials.

Expert Panelist

Purpose: Serve as a panelist in a 3-hour in-person, moderated discussion with 4-6 other experts at a half-day in-person event. Engage directly with the audience through live Q&A and interactive discussions, sharing expertise, insights, resources, and practical guidance on key topics relevant to the condo community.

Time Commitment: Approx. 7-10 hours

- In-Person Event: 3-4 hours
- Coordination with CCI Staff & Other Panelists: 3-4 hours
- Individual Preparation: Estimated 1-2 hours as needed

ACE Breakout Session Presenter

Purpose: Deliver a concise, impactful 20-minute presentation as part of a 90-minute breakout session at the Alberta Condo Expo (ACE), collaborating with 1-2 other experts to provide valuable insights on a specific condominium topic.

Time Commitment: Approx. 7-9 hours

- Presentation Time: ~20-30 minutes (as part of a 90-minute Breakout Session)
- Coordination with CCI Staff: 1-2 hours.
- Collaboration with Co-Presenters: 2-3 hours.
- Individual Preparation: Estimated 2-3 hours for developing presentation and materials.
